- Prototypes

- **Motion 16 (Northumberland - Duncan Thomas)**
- This conference urges NHS England to adopt a greater degree of flexibility in relation to small practices in rural areas closing for dentists' and staff holidays.

- **Motion 25 (Manchester - Jim Rochford)**
- This conference deplors the prototype dental contract as a regressive development
  
- **Motion 26 (Lincolnshire - Jason Wong)**
- This conference calls for some of the prototypes to be on a full capitation model thus dispensing with the discredited and despised UDA system.

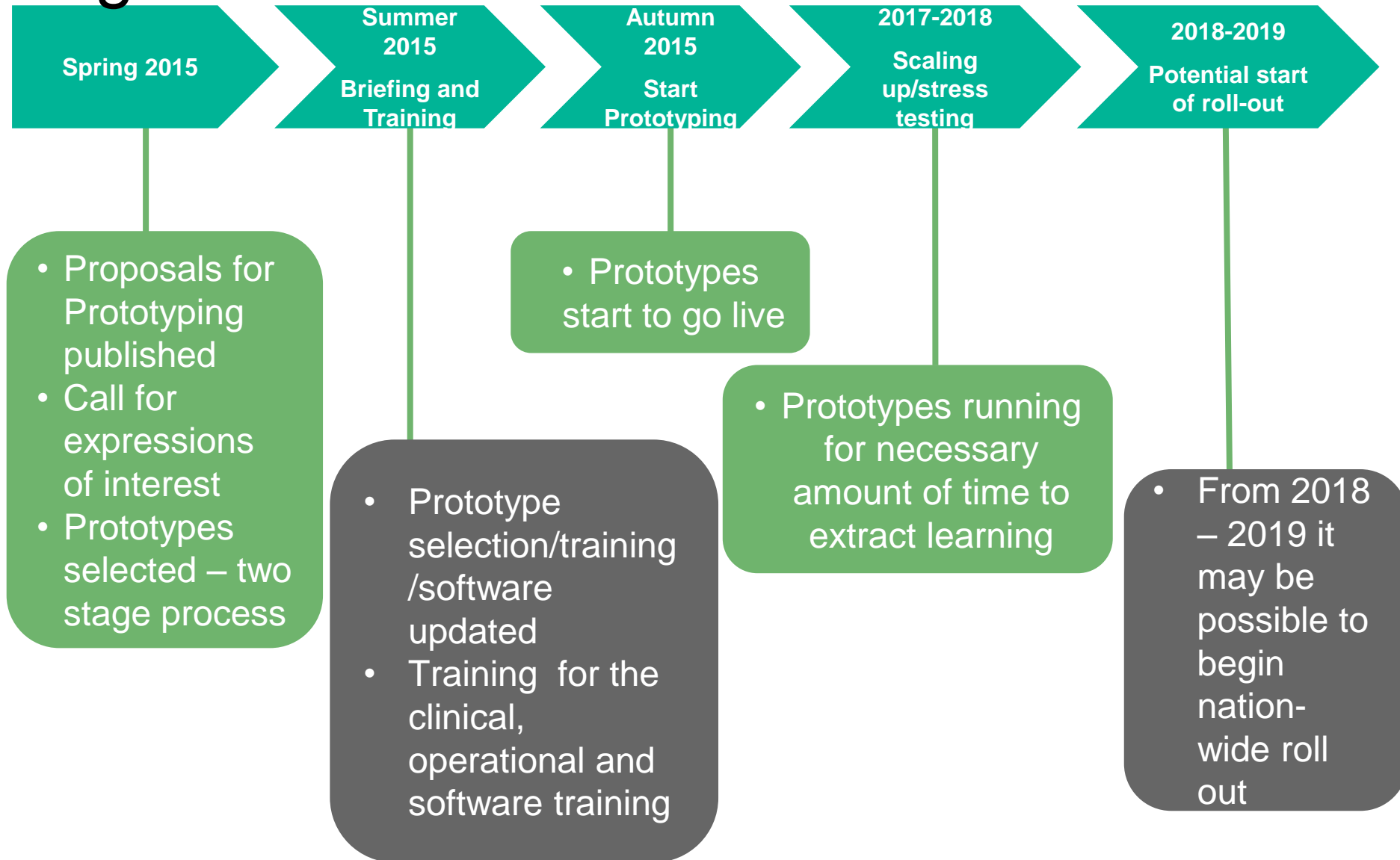
- **Motion 10 (Trafford - Mark Barratt)**
- This conference urges Indemnity organisations to take a more sympathetic view in dealing with dentists who have made mistakes. Such dentists should not be thrown to the wolves i.e refused further cover other than in the most extreme cases.

- MDDUS, DDU and DPL
- All encourages members to seek advice as often as members see fit. No “black mark”
- All say that non-renewals are very rare, but all say it happens

- Rise in fees for “high risk” individuals
  - MDDUS doesn’t do this at all
  - DPL rarely raises, max. 3-5 times “normal” fee
  - DDU rarely raises, but fees can be raised to more than £50 000 per year



# High level timeline for reform



- Blend A: UDA band 1 = Capitation  
UDA band 2 & 3 = UDAs
- Blend B: UDA band 1 & 2 = Capitation
- UDA band 3 = UDAs

- Minimum Activity Level (UDA) reductions
- Band 2 = 20%
- Band 3 = 30%
  
- Exceeding minimum activity level will not release extra payment
